



Thank you for your correspondence regarding the above-mentioned project. For this proposed project, Indian and Northern Affairs Canada is not likely to require an environmental assessment under s. 5(1) of the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act and will not be a responsible authority.

Additionally, Indian and Northern Affairs Canada will not be an expert federal authority and further involvement is not necessary.
